We at No Limits Academy know that a successful school experience occurs when parents give evidence of being:

- Committed to the programs and activities that support the school

Racial Nondiscriminatory Policy

We at No Limits Academy admit qualified students of any race, color, sex, national or ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available at our school.

Admission Priorities

No Limits Academy has a waiting list in which candidates are evaluated by therapist(s) and No Limits Academy Director for classroom placement and selected based on openings in that classroom.

The Administrator interviews the families of the prospective students to determine the commitment of parents and students, and the ability of the school to meet the individual needs of the candidate.

No Limits Academy specializes in the education of students with physical and complex disabilities. No Limits Academy will evaluate students with other disabilities in addition to physical disabilities on a case-by-case basis with respect to the school's ability to provide those students a quality education. No Limits Academy may decline to enroll a student if the school determines, at its sole discretion, that it cannot adequately serve the needs of the candidate.

Age

No Limits Academy accepts students ages 5 to 22 years.

Applications

Applications for No Limits Academy are accepted throughout the school year, based on availability. Parents may pick up an application at the school office or download the appropriate form from the website.

Academic Readiness

All prospective students are evaluated by a speech-language pathologist, occupational therapist and physical therapist as adequate of the students' impairments. The No Limits Academy Director observes the students during the therapy evaluations and conducts a cognitive evaluation. No Limits Academy also reviews past placement/screening tests given by prior schools, IEPs, report cards, therapy plans of care, etc to determine classroom placement.

Required Forms

For admission, parents are required to present:

- Application
- New student packet
- Copy of child's birth certificate
- Copy of parent's driver license
- Evidence of compliance with immunization requirements
- Mandated health forms
- Previous IEPs
- Previous school records
